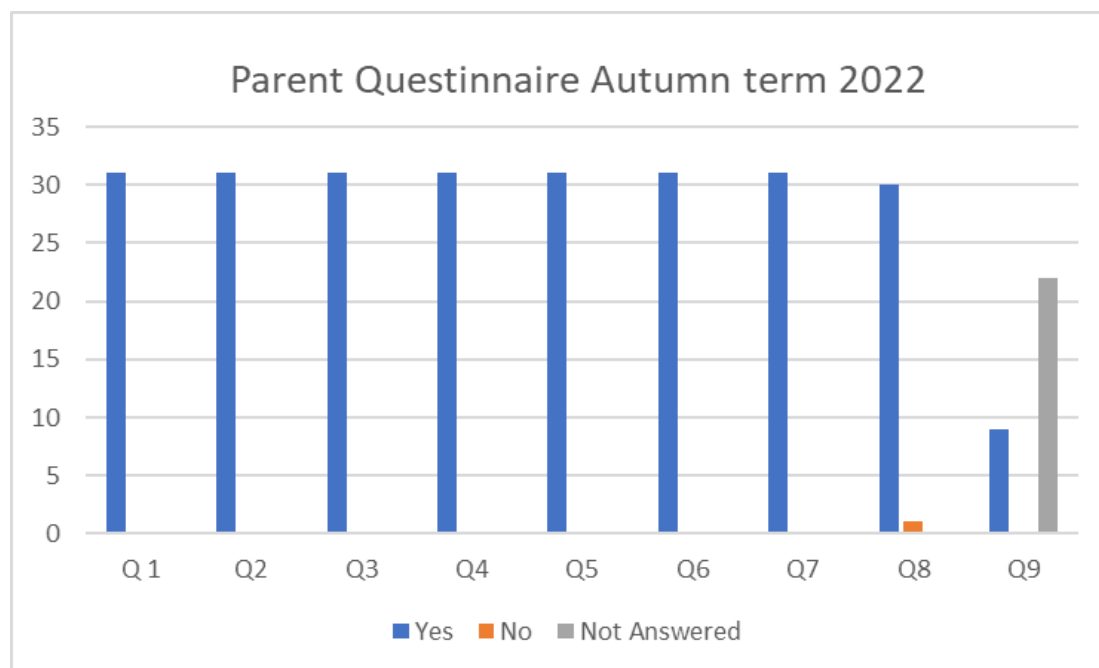


Parent Questionnaire Autumn Term 2022



Capturing parents' voices is vital in ensuring we can continue to strengthen the good practice already in place in school. 46% of parents took part in the parent questionnaire

The data from the questionnaire tells us 100% of parents/carers who took part in the questionnaire feel that their children are happy and well supported at Jakeman Nursery. 100% of parents feel staff are approachable and informative and 100% of parents who took part in the questionnaire feel Jakeman is a welcoming and friendly environment.

100% of parents access information through parent text, school website and Facebook, where all letters, newsletters are shared, and feel this is helpful. 100% of parents who took part felt they are involved in their child's learning in nursery.

The data informs us that 100% of parents who have a child who has special educational needs feel their needs are supported in school

Actions Points

Q8 – Do you know who your child's key worker is? 98% of parents know who their child's key person is, this is done through transition into nursery and regular communication with parents. However, we must ensure 100% of parents know this information, this is vital for both the child and parents. We have since actioned a parent consultation whereby key workers have ensured parents know their names. Letters sent to new parents informing them of their child's place and start date, now also include their child's key workers name.
